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## **School District of Omro Gym Floor Sanding and Refinishing RFP**

The School District of Omro is currently requesting proposals for the following Gym Floor Sanding and Refinishing project:

### **Middle Gym Floor 10,000 square feet:**

1. Sand, seal, and refinish floor with four (4) coats of rebounder VOC Compliant High Build Gym Finish
2. Reapply the following game lines to the floor
  - a. One (1) main basketball court with 3-point line
  - b. Two (2) side basketball courts with 3-point line
  - c. One (1) main volleyball court
  - d. Two (2) practice volleyball courts
3. Proposal should include removal and disposal of materials
4. Warranty information should be documented
5. Installation should be included

### **PAC Gym Floor 8,800 square feet:**

1. Sand, seal, and refinish floor with four (4) coats of rebounder VOC Compliant High Build Gym Finish
2. Reapply the following game lines to the floor
  - a. One (1) main basketball court with 3-point line
  - b. Two (2) side basketball courts with 3-point line
  - c. One (1) main volleyball court
  - d. Two (2) practice volleyball courts
  - e. Six (6) badminton single and double courts.
3. Proposal should include removal and disposal of materials
4. Warranty information should be documented
5. Installation should be included

The District has been approved for a 2010 Qualified School Construction Bond (QSCB) allocation for this project. The following requirements must be met to assist the District in complying with this federal assistance:

1. The proposals should comply with the Davis Bacon Act
2. The contractor should submit to the District weekly copies of all payroll associated with the project and a certification of compliance with the Davis Bacon Act

Proposals should be submitted separately for each gym. The School District of Omro successfully passed a maintenance referendum on July 12, 2011 to secure funding for this project. The District reserves the right to award each contract as it sees fit and to negotiate the projects time period with the vendor. The District reserves the right to reject or accept any or all proposals. It should be noted that the District is a tax-exempt organization.

Deadline for submitting proposals is August 18, 2011 by 12 noon. Bids should be marked to the attention of the Board of Education and sent or delivered SEALED. They can be mailed to 455 Fox Trail, Omro, WI 54963. Awards may start as early as August 23, 2011, but no later than 90 days after the RFP deadline.
